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	27	I, Carole Thompson, declare as follows:	
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1. I am the Associate Director of Case Management for CPT Group, Inc. ("Settlement Administrator" or "CPT"), the Settlement Administrator jointly agreed upon by the Parties and approved by the Court for *Zucchero v. Heirloom Roses, Inc.* I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called upon to testify, I could and would testify competently to such facts.

2. On December 22, 2023, Notice of the settlement was sent to all 51,907 Settlement Class Members via mail or email. Of these, 61 notices were returned as undeliverable. As a result, we were able to effectively notify the majority of class members. A total of 275 valid claim forms were submitted, representing 0.53% of the total class members. Additionally, there was one opt-out, accounting for 0.002% of the Settlement Class, and no objections, representing 0% of the Settlement Class.

3. On May 21, 2024, the Court granted final approval of the settlement. The Court approved administrative costs in the amount of \$40,000, which were paid separately by the Defendant. On August 14, 2024, CPT received a check in the amount of \$51,110, which covered the total amount designated for Settlement Awards and CPT's fees.

4. On August 23, 2024, CPT issued 275 payments from the Settlement Fund,
representing individual settlement awards to valid Settlement Class Members. These payments,
totaling \$11,110, were disbursed via electronic methods such as PayPal or Venmo, and paper
checks. The payments ranged from a minimum of \$20 to a maximum of \$200 with an average of
\$40.40 and a median of \$40 per claimant.

Settlement Class Members have 180 days from the date of issuance, until February
 19, 2025, to cash their settlement awards. As of the date of this declaration, one payment has been
 cashed; it is too early to determine the total number or value of checks that remain uncashed.

6. The administrative costs for the settlement amount to \$40,000, and the attorneys'
fees and costs total \$198,500, which were paid separately by the Defendant. This information will
be posted on the settlement website within 21 days after all funds have been paid to class members.

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
